The fruity start unfolds into a more serious and contemplative phase, marked by subtle hints of forest floor, damp earth, and savoury spices.

This contrast of a lively, fruity start, balanced mid-palate weight, and the serious, earthy, savoury finish, showcases the wine's impeccable structure. This Pinot Noir is a testament to the art of winemaking, offering a harmonious narrative that dances on the palate, leaving a lasting impression of balance and refinement.
